

EI Interactive Features:

- **Chat Rooms**- Chat rooms offer program participants the opportunity to have ongoing discussions concerning the program content, issues at their schools, and an opportunity to share ideas with educators across the country.
- **Bulletin Boards**- Schools and districts can post assignments to bulletin boards for group review and discussions.
- **Search Engine**- Users can search all of EI's content to find just the learning segments they are looking for and link directly to that part of the program.
- **Ask a Question of the Speaker**- Users can pause video segments and post questions to speakers and or other participants. Responses to questions are provided by experts in audio and written form.
- **24x7 Help Desk**- Users can request live technical assistance at home or at school at the click of a button.
- **Program Tracking and Bookmarks**- Users can see on the main navigation bar precisely where they left off when they last visited.
- **Assessments**- Each section has a randomly selected, multiple-choice assessment.
- **Streaming Video**- Video available in high and low bandwidth settings.
- **Administration Access**- An assigned administrator has the ability to track individual user participation by program and assessment.
- **Resource Library and Links**- Users can query a comprehensive list of additional resources and web sites pertaining to program topics.

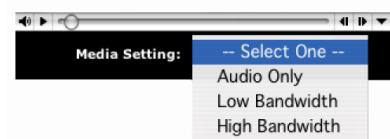
